
The following are reasons as to why the fee structure was raised:

- For the past four academic years, the cost of inflation which was used as a benchmark for increasing fees has not been considered.
- Machabeng College fees has not been raised for the last five academic years which has led to expenditure growing above the income.
- The CIS has directed the college to change the fee structure so that it can cater for the College's needs to meet the international education standards.
